

# HISTORY

In 2008 the Summit Hill Fire destroyed 35 homes in the Santa Cruz Mountains. Soon after the fire Jim went up to the fire area and discovered people living in tents and cars and no one helping them. Jim and a few friends started helping them. Soon it grew to over 190 volunteers helping for several years and out of that effort grew Fishnet Care and Share. Currently, with daily food donations, between one and two thousand people are being fed with the help of volunteers.
